H002 – Indemnification of Government Assets

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The Subcontractor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the US Government and ASES, LLC dba Field Aerospace against any and all losses, claims, liabilities, and expenses, for aircraft costs and aircraft component costs logistically supported under subcontracts written under this prime contract, which are in the care, custody or control of the Subcontractor while on the Subcontractor's premises or Field Aerospace's premises or the premises of lower tier vendors/subcontractors. Reimbursement of any damage to or loss of an aircraft will not exceed the replacement cost of that particular aircraft, including all modifications and improvements. Acts of God are expressly excluded unless provisions to cover these occurrences are covered by the Contractor's insurance policies.
